ACCESSIBILITY TO THE CAVA

The first stage of the visit takes place at the reception of Recaredo, a space conceived without architectural barriers and well adapted for visitors with reduced mobility.

The route presents architectural barriers to access the first floor of the cellar and is not accessible to people with reduced mobility, but we have an audiovisual at the entrance that allows visitors to know in depth our values and our philosophy as vinegrowers and winemakers.

The route features 20 steps down to the first floor of the cellar and 20 steps down to the second floor. At the end of the visit, there are stairs that go up with 23 steps to access the winery and, finally, 5 more steps to access the tasting rooms.



ACCESS ALLOWED TO GUIDE DOGS

Guide and assistance dogs are welcome to the winery, cellar and tasting rooms.



ADAPTED TOILETS

Visitors can find adapted toilets in the visitor reception area.



CHANGING TABLE FOR BABIES

The adapted toilets in the reception area have changing tables for babies.
